## Youth Ambassadors Meeting 18<sup>th</sup> February Mitchell Library

### Summary

#### 1. Purpose of the group

It was agreed that the purpose of the group would be:

- to investigate what young people felt positive learning experiences looked like
- to gather examples of practice that young people have appreciated

#### 2. What does positive PSE experiences look/feel/sound like?

Relaxed, chilled, more discussion, demonstrates progression, avoids repetition, relates to real life, up to date, current, sharing ideas and experiences, confident and enthusiastic teachers, felt safe, inclusive, non-judgemental, meets different learning styles, access to experts, work with partners in the community, access to 1-1 advice, varied, can choose how you learn, access to information, opportunities to research information, opportunities for peer led experiences, practical, experiential, access to real people who can talk about their experiences

#### 3. How do we find out more?

Ambassadors reported that they had or were in the process of collecting information within their authorities and it was agreed that we would make time to share this learning at the next session

#### 4. Where are their positive examples of PSE learning experiences?

Some examples were shared:

- Practical experiences – CPR, Experiential learning
- Visiting speakers – sharing experience of young offending
- Learning from peers – MVP, Girl guides, pupils going back to primary 7 to share experiences/planned lessons around substance misuse
- Discussion led – activities led by youth workers at youth groups

### Actions

1. Youth Ambassadors from each local authority to prepare a 5-10 presentation (formal or informal) about **what** data they have collected about the PSE curriculum sharing **how** they collected it and the results (if they have them)

2. Youth Ambassadors from each authority to find out any contacts to share examples of positive PSE learning experiences under the following headings:

- Discussion Led
- Partnership Working
- Practical
- Enquiry Led
- Peer Led

No detail is necessary at this time – only **what** and **where**
