

# Senior Phase

- Aligning provision of vocational course options in the Senior Phase (West Dunbartonshire, East Renfrewshire, Renfrewshire and Inverclyde).
- Creating this joined up approach required collaborative working in bidding for, and publicising , course options.
- Without this partnership, these courses would not have run due to lack of viability, and young people would have missed out.
- Resulted in a large number of students accessing courses with their peers from other local authorities.
